

Hello from the clinic at Whitesburg Middle School, my name is Vida Walls and I am the school nurse. I am usually available from 8:00 am -3:00 pm.

Any student that requires medication at school must have a signed School Medication Prescriber/Parent Authorization on file. It must be signed by both the parent and the physician. There are certain physicians that have left standing orders for Tylenol – Acetaminophen, Advil – Ibuprofen, Benadryl - Diphenhydramine, and Dramamine - Dimenhydrinate. I have a list of the physicians in the clinic. The nurse can sign for these orders. Students are not allowed to bring the medication to school, it must be dropped off by the parent/guardian.

Students with asthma, diabetes, seizure disorders, or severe allergies, have separate emergency plans which also require a parent and physician signature. These plans are necessary for your child to carry his or her inhaler or Epi-pen. We encourage you to get these emergency plans turned in as soon as possible.
